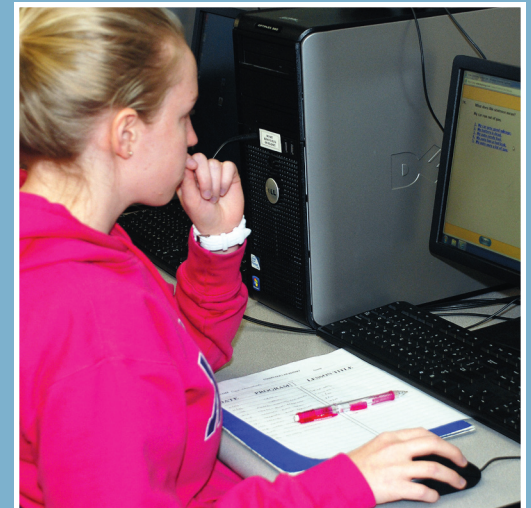

## The Mission of PEPI

PEPI provides a supportive learning atmosphere. Staff members work one-on-one and in classroom settings to enable learners to move as quickly as possible to achieve their educational goals.



## Registration

Interested adults, 19 years and older, must register at the office of PEPI, 609 Ember Drive, New Iberia, La. in order to enter the program. A fee of \$5 is paid at registration. Learners 17 and 18 years old, must provide an official "Drop Form" from Iberia Parish School Board.

## Orientation

A two-day orientation is held once a month. Adult learners must attend prior to acceptance in the program.



## Day Class

Two sessions of daytime classes are offered.

Session 1: Monday & Wednesday

Session 2: Tuesday & Thursday

Both sessions meet from  
8 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

Guided study is available from  
1–3 p.m. for both sessions;  
Friday from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.

## Independent Study

Participants of both sessions may attend an independent study day on Friday from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.
