## Catherine Ann Kallhoff, SSND

*60 years*

**S**ister Catherine Ann began her mission experience teaching for 19 years in the intermediate and secondary grades in Minnesota and North Dakota. After a few years as a secondary administrator in Mandaree, North Dakota, she worked as a pastoral minister in parishes there. In 1975 she became an education consultant for the Diocese of Bismarck, taught at Mary College in the same city, was superintendent at Bishop Ryan High School in Minot and the Diocese of Crookston, Minnesota. For the next 15 years, Sister Catherine Ann was the Director of Total Education in the Diocese of St. Cloud, Minnesota. Just before her retirement in 2010, she was a spiritual director as well as a teacher at St. John's University in Collegeville, Minnesota.

### **A blessing of these years I want to share is**

the completion of a collection of many talks and lectures I gave around the country, and printing them into a book. My focus was often on leadership of women in the Church and in the workplace.

### **A ministry experience I treasure was**

serving as the Superintendent of Schools in the Diocese of St. Cloud. A particular achievement was in the development of Five Year Plans in Education and Faith Formation in all of the parishes. It was a dialogic process involving the Catholic Education Ministries (CEM) staff, clergy, diocesan deaneries, parish school personnel and parishioners. It was a very successful undertaking.

### **A very meaningful experience I had**

was securing scholarships for several young women, giving them the opportunity to receive a degree in the profession of their choice. This enabled them to become independent and employable.
