Florida and Washington, D.C. Previously, she served as the president/CEO of the African American Chamber of Commerce of Wisconsin, where she led the renewal of the organization.

Her focus is on economic vibrancy for African Americans and other underserved communities through education, employment, advocacy and economic self-reliance and development. Along the way, she became co-founder of the African American Women's Project Fund, created to support organizations that promote the well-being of women and girls. Dr. Hall was recognized by Milwaukee Business Journal as one of their "Executives to Watch in 2021," and she was inducted into their "40 Under 40 Hall of Fame."
