

How to Update Adobe Reader



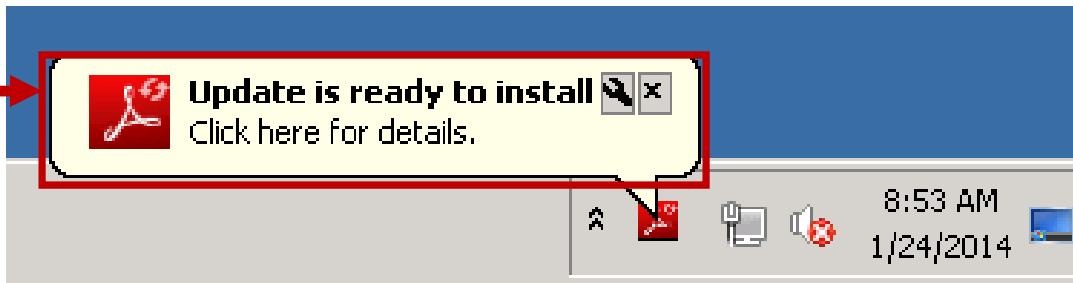

Installing the free Adobe Reader updates will ensure that your Adobe application continues to run safely and efficiently.

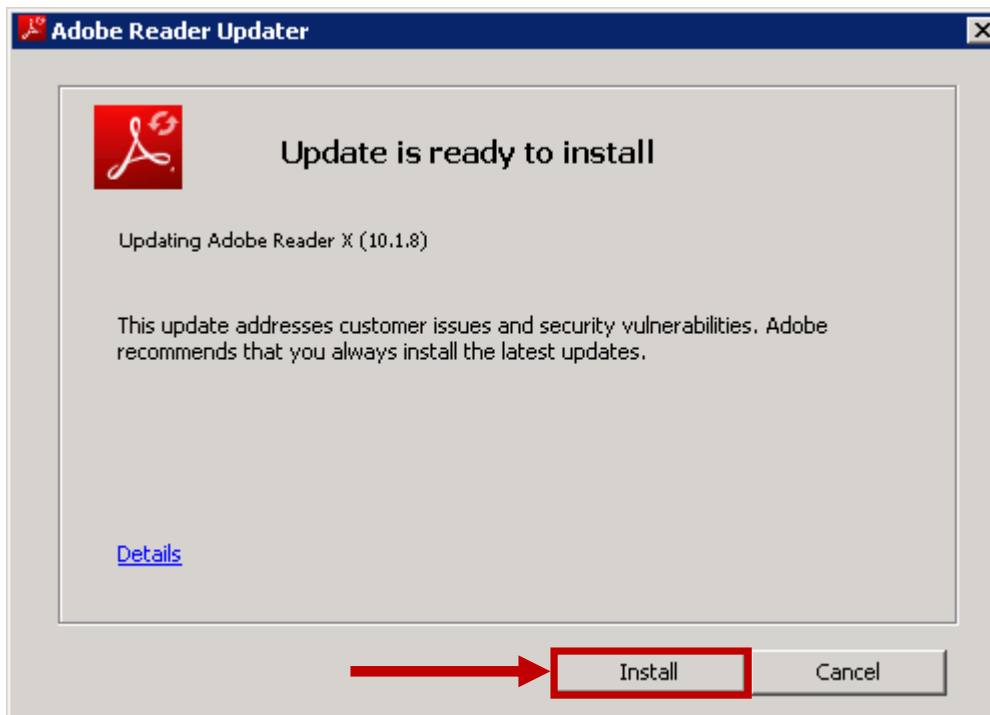
You may be wondering what Adobe Reader is and why you need to update it so frequently. Adobe Reader is the trusted standard for reliably viewing, printing, signing, and commenting on PDF documents. It's the only PDF viewer that can open and interact with all types of PDF content — including forms and multimedia — and is available across leading desktop and mobile device platforms. Updating it will improve the software's performance, stability, resolve any security flaws in the software, and ensure you have the latest features the program offers so you should install updates as they become available.

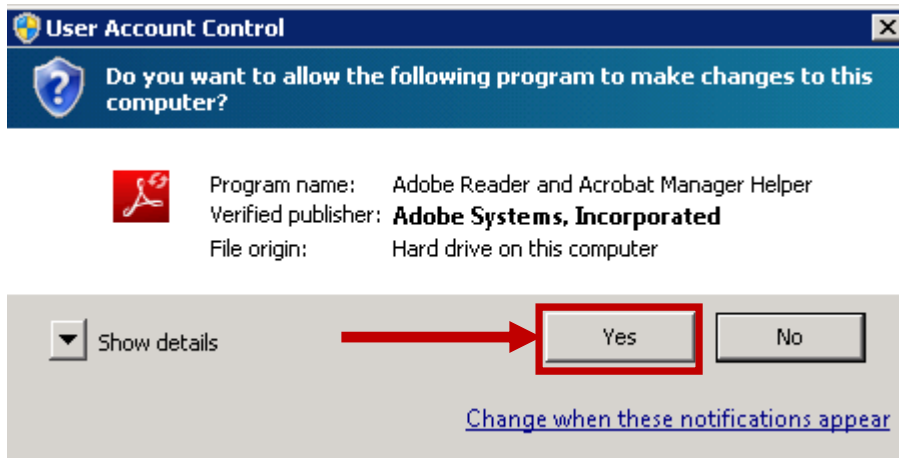
1. When you see the Adobe Reader Update notification pop-up in the bottom right hand corner of your system, *click* on the notification bubble to begin the update process.



2. *Click* **Install** to allow the Adobe Reader Updater to begin the installation.



3. The User Account Control window appears. *Click Yes* to allow the installation to proceed.



4. The installation progress will be displayed. Once completed, *click Close*. In some cases the update may request a restart. If so, save and close of of any files you have open and then *click Restart* to finish the process. Your computer will automatically reboot to finish the update process.
