From 1973 to 1987, Sister Kathleen Mary served at parishes in Clara City, Willmar and Waverly, Minnesota. She was elected to the Mankato Provincial Council in 1987. After serving one term on the council, Sister Kathleen Mary enrolled at St. Mary's College. In 1993 she joined the staff at Good Counsel Education Center in Mankato, Minnesota. From 1995 to 2004 Sister Kathleen Mary served as Director of Outreach and Justice at St. Gerard Parish in Brooklyn Park, Minnesota. In 2005, Sister Kathleen Mary was asked to serve the SSND community both as Director of Third Age Ministry in St. Paul, Minnesota, and as Director of CESRM, the Center for Earth Spirituality and Rural Ministry, at Our Lady of Good Counsel. When the Third Age Ministry ended in 2009, she continued with CESRM, becoming Co-Director in 2010.
