After 10 years teaching, Sister Elizabeth began 25 years of pastoral ministry in parishes, hospitals, and chemical dependency centers in Arizona, Louisiana, Missouri and Texas. In 1994, she returned to the classroom, this time teaching adult students at Progressive Education Program, Inc. (PEPI), an SSND sponsored ministry in New Iberia, Louisiana. In 1998, Sister Elizabeth was asked to join the SSND community ministering at St. Peter Elementary School in Pine Bluff, Arkansas. She would later move to Marrero, Louisiana, and then to St. Mary of the Pines in Chatawa, Mississippi, where she continues her community service and volunteer activities.
