60 Years

Sister Kenneth Marie was born in Grand Rapids, Michigan, in 1930. Named Lorraine Kozal, she has been known for the past 60 years as Sister Kenneth Marie. She served as a homemaker in the community of the School Sisters of Notre Dame. After graduating from Catholic Central in 1948, she entered the motherhouse in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 1949. In 1964, she returned to West Catholic Convent and served the Sisters for 15 years. For six years, she also cooked in the SSND Generalate in Rome, Italy. She had the privilege of being in Rome for the beatification of SSND Foundress, Mother Theresa of Jesus Gerhardinger in 1985 and attended the Beatification of her distant cousin, Michael Kozal, held in Warsaw, Poland in 1987. Returning to the United States in 1989, she worked at Villa Elizabeth Nursing Home in Grand Rapids where her father was, until he died. In 1993, she returned to Milwaukee and worked three years at St. Mary's Hospital in the kitchen. The last 14 years were spent at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Convent in Mount Calvary, Wisconsin. Recently, she moved to Notre Dame of Elm Grove where she continues to minister through her service, prayer and presence.
