Sister Mayette began ministry as a home service sister at St. John Catholic Church in Mankato, Minnesota. From 1947 to 1964 she would serve the Mankato Province overseeing boarding students attending the Academy of Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota. Sister Mayette continued service to the SSND community in St. Paul, Fridley and Winona, Minnesota; St. Pius and New Hradec, North Dakota; and in Rome, Italy. In 1973, she began several years of ministry to unwed mothers through Cabrini Residence in Winona, Minnesota. In 1981, Sister Mayette began 19 years in pastoral ministry, first at St. Stanislaus in St. Paul and then at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Hastings, Minnesota. Retired from full-time ministry in 1991, she continued volunteer community ministry to the elderly and infirm of Hastings, Minnesota. Since 2000, Sister Mayette continues to serve the community and church through prayer and presence as a resident of Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota.
