Holding bachelor's and master's degrees in education and history, she taught for 47 years at the elementary, middle and high school levels in Missouri, Mississippi, Arkansas and Louisiana. In 1979 Sister Alix le Clerc left the classroom for parish ministry, joining the staff at St. Gerard Parish in San Antonio, Texas. Eight years later, she would begin five years of ministry at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Jeanerette, Louisiana. In 1992 she retired from full-time ministry, moving to St. Mary of the Pines in Chatawa, Mississippi., to offer community service. Since 2004, Sister Alix le Clerc has served the SSND community through prayer and presence.
