**S***ister Rose* has ministered as an educator for more than 50 years, primarily teaching junior high students. All of her education posts have been in Wisconsin, including: St. Boniface, St. Leo, St. Anthony, St. Rose, St. Thomas Aquinas and Notre Dame Middle School in Milwaukee; Sacred Heart in Appleton; St. Mary in De Pere; St. Agnes in Butler; St. Joseph Orphanage in Green Bay; St. Patrick in Beaver Dam; St. Kilian in Hartford and St. Hubert in Hubertus. Additionally, she served as principal at St. Francis Xavier in De Pere and St. Peter in Beaver Dam. Sister Rose earned a bachelor's in education and sociology from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and a master's in English and guidance from Loyola University of Chicago. She retired from full-time teaching in 2010 but continues to serve at Notre Dame Middle School as a volunteer teacher.
