Sister Katherine began her ministry at St. Leo Catechetical School in Pipestone, Minnesota, teaching catechesis and serving the congregation. Beginning in 1967, she answered a call to provide care, transportation and food service for the SSND sisters living at Mankato's Good Counsel Convent, serving more than two decades in this ministry. In 1989, she began a one-year ministry in elder care. Throughout the 1990s, Sister Katherine worked in telemarketing for several St. Paul firms and fulfilled various roles for Kelly Temporary Services in Minneapolis. In 2001 she returned to serving the SSND community at Good Counsel Convent in Mankato, a ministry which continues today.
