# **Mary Elsa Bren, SSND**



ister Mary Elsa's earliest ministries spanned the World War II years and through the 1950s, when she served the SSND congregation as a housekeeper in the towns of Colton, Washington; St. Leo, Minnesota; St. Donatus, Iowa; New Salem and New Hradec, North Dakota; and Mankato and Shakopee, Minnesota. She served as a primary grade teacher in Dayton, Minnesota from 1959-1963. Subsequent roles in both teaching and domestic assistance throughout the next decade took her to Clarkston, Washington; the Minnesota towns of Bloomington, Searles, and back to Mankato, where she served at Good Counsel Convent from 1976-1981. For the next decade, Sister Mary Elsa alternated her ministries between housekeeping for the SSND community and visiting the sick in the parishes of Dickinson, North Dakota. Since 1992, she has devoted herself as a prayer witness at the Good Counsel Convent in Mankato, Minnesota.
