In 1994, Sister Pat moved to the Diocese of Jefferson City in Missouri to serve as the pastoral minister at St. Patrick Parish in Rolla, and later at Sacred Heart Parish in Columbia. She currently is the pastoral minister at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish for the diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. Sister Pat holds a bachelor's in English from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis, a master's in library Science from Rosary University in River Forest, Illinois, and a master's in religious studies from St. Louis University.*
