Sister Annette spent her early ministry years teaching Catholic grade school students in Minneapolis, Jordan and Savage, Minnesota. She spent one year in education in Waterloo, Iowa, then returned to the Twin Cities area to teach at St. Mary grade school in Shakopee from 1976 through 1981. She continued her ministry of education at St. Anne in Wabasso and St. Peter in Forest Lake. In 1985, she answered a call to serve at St. Paul's Loyalty Spirituality Center in an administrative capacity, a ministry which lasted through mid-1993. She returned for a time to clerical roles in elementary schools around the Diocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis, serving at Immaculate Conception, Sandcastle and Holy Childhood schools. In 2002, Sister Annette began a 12-year stint as a teacher at St. Joseph Grade School in Rosemount. Since 2014, she has served in elementary schools around the Twin Cities. She holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in elementary education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.

When I was a young sister, I was moved from place to place three years in a row, all because I was the youngest one. There needed to be a cut of personnel, as there was beginning to be a shortage of sisters working in our schools. At the end of that third year, I was once again to be the one who had to leave.
