## **Sister Jane Weisgram, SSND**

*Sister Jane's first decade of ministry as a middle and high school teacher took her to seven different Catholic parishes across four states. Her travels continued from 1980 through 1987, when she taught in North Dakota, Iowa and Florida. She then served two years each in Dayton, Ohio, as campus minister, and Cedar Rapids, Iowa, as director of religious education and of the RCIA program. From 1991 through 2000, Sister Jane devoted herself to the parishioners at Holy Spirit Church in Rochester, Minnesota, as a pastoral associate. She discerned a ministry in Africa, and joined the SSND community in Jos, Nigeria, where she accepted a role as a lecturer at St. Augustine Major Seminary, serving for seven years. In 2009, she moved to Fairmont, Minnesota, working as director of RCIA and adult faith formation at St. John Vianney Parish. Her more recent assignments as pastoral associate were in the Iowa diocese of Davenport. In mid-2016, she accepted a full-time pastoral minister role at St. Martin parish in Jefferson City, where she continues today. She holds a bachelor's in social studies from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In later years, she earned master's degrees in American Catholic Church history and pastoral theology.*
