Sister Janet's ministry began in Grand Rapids, Michigan, where she taught at St. Adalbert grade school from 1969 through 1975. She devoted the next 13 years to serving in the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend, Indiana, beginning with eight years as a teacher and administrator at Saints Peter and Paul grade school in Huntington. From 1983 through 1987, she served as associate superintendent of education for the diocese. Sister Janet turned to congregational service, serving at the motherhouse of the former Milwaukee Province as treasurer through 2009. Following a yearlong sabbatical, she continued living and serving in the Milwaukee-Elm Grove area, including serving as the community team leader at Notre Dame of Elm Grove. Her ministry of prayer and presence continues there. She earned a bachelor's in education with a minor in mathematics from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. She holds a master's in elementary administration from Central Michigan University.
