Sister Judy Ann's ministry began in Catholic grade schools around Missouri and Illinois, where she served from 1969 through 1977. She spent four years teaching at St. Vincent grade school in Keokuk, Iowa, then returned to St. Louis for a nine-year period at St. Bridget in Pacific, Missouri. Following a period of renewal, she served part-time at Notre Dame and Holy Family Preschools in St. Louis. In 1996, she turned to congregational ministry, working at SSND's Villa Gesu retirement home in St. Louis. From 2000 through 2011, Sister Judy Ann served as an in-home caregiver with CSJ Care in St. Louis. Since then, she has worked full-time in administration at Anna House in Bridgeton. She earned a bachelor's in American Studies at the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis, adding a master's in reading education from Clarke College in Iowa in 1983.

I have been able to do what I love by being able to teach young people between the ages of three and 10 years of age for 27 years.
