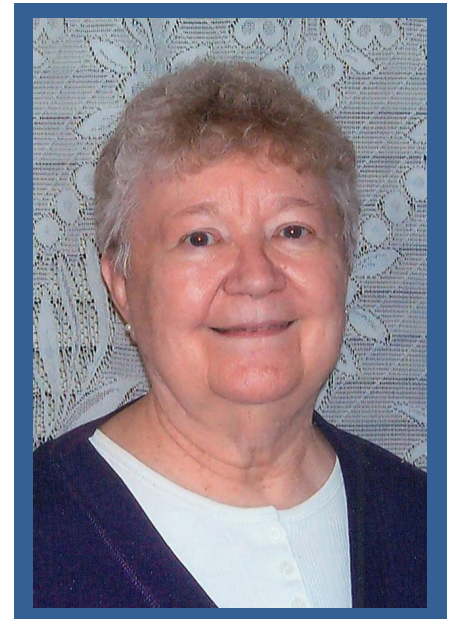

Sister Catherine DeWitt, SSND

Sister Catherine began her ministry as a Catholic grade school teacher in Louisiana and California. In 1972, she returned to the Midwest, accepting a role as a special education administrator in the East St. Louis Deanery of the Belleville Diocese in Illinois. She moved back to California in 1981, working in both parish ministry and special education for another five years. She served in several parishes in Jefferson City, Missouri, during the late 1980s, then turned to helping serve on the motherhouse staff in St. Louis. Sister Catherine transitioned from full- to part-time ministry in 2004, serving as a nurse's aide at the Sancta Maria in Ripa infirmary in St. Louis through 2009. She began caring for family members in Belleville in 2009, and today continues in that role, as well as serving through prayer and presence. She holds a bachelor's of history from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis and a master's of education in reading from California's Loyola Marymount.
