Sister Jeanne Marie's early ministry years began in Albuquerque, New Mexico, as a choir director, musician and second grade teacher. She then continued as a musician and teacher in Catholic grade schools across Missouri. In 1970, she moved to the Diocese of San Diego to teach and serve in music and administration at St. Jude Academy through 1980. She returned for several years to St. Louis, serving in administration at St. Engelbert. Called back to San Diego, Sister Jeanne Marie spent the next 15 years as a teacher and computer specialist at St. Rita grade school. Her current ministry is as a special needs teacher at St. Theresa School in Denver, where she has lived since 2000. She earned a bachelor's in mathematics from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis in 1962. She later earned a master's in private school administration from the University of San Francisco.
