Sister Marlene Manney, SSND

Sister Marlene began teaching in Minnesota Catholic grade schools around Winona, Canby and Minneapolis/St. Paul following her first profession of vows in 1957. From 1977 through 1982, she taught at St. Michael School in Prior Lake. After serving for a period as a nurse's aide in Appleton, Sister Marlene turned to congregational services as a local leader at Our Lady of Good Counsel. During the 1990s, she was called to Lexington, Kentucky, where she assisted in studies on health and aging, serving as a resource staff member and later as a part-time researcher. She returned to Our Lady of Good Counsel in Mankato in 2001 for a period of prayer witness and recuperation. She continues her ministry of prayer and presence there today. Sister Marlene earned a bachelor's in elementary education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee in 1968.
