## **Sister Mary Carla Huebner, SSND**

She moved to St. Mary High School in Menasha from 1979 through 1983. For the next 26 years, she devoted herself to students at Mount Mary University as an associate professor. Beginning in 2009, she shared her artistic talents with the SSND community and beyond, and also served in prayerful presence. Since 2013, she has resided at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, continuing her prayerful witness. She earned a bachelor's in art with a minor in English from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. She holds master's degrees in both art and art education, earned in 1975 and 1991, respectively.*
