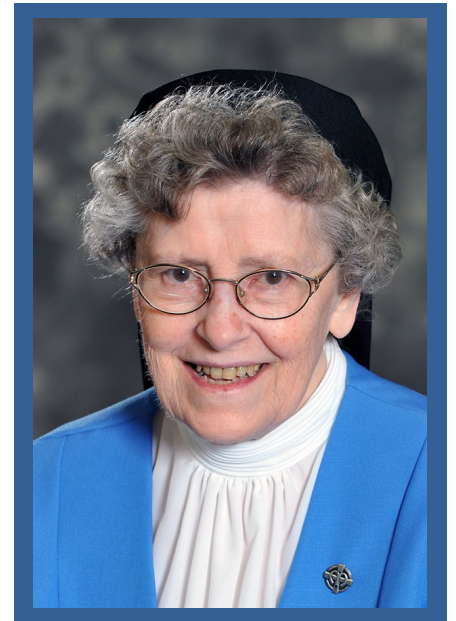

Sister Lawrence Marie followed her first profession of vows with roles as a Catholic grade school teacher in the Dioceses of Superior, La Crosse, and Milwaukee, Wisconsin. In Wisconsin, she taught at St. Paul in Bloomer from 1968 through 1974, then answered a call at St. Aloysius in West Allis, teaching there for 23 years. Sister Lawrence Marie began serving in staff roles for the congregation and as a volunteer at Milwaukee area nursing homes through the early 2000s. She volunteered as a minister to the elderly at Notre Dame of Elm Grove from 2005 through 2012. She continues to serve there through prayer and presence. Sister Lawrence Marie earned a bachelor's in English with a minor in history from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.
