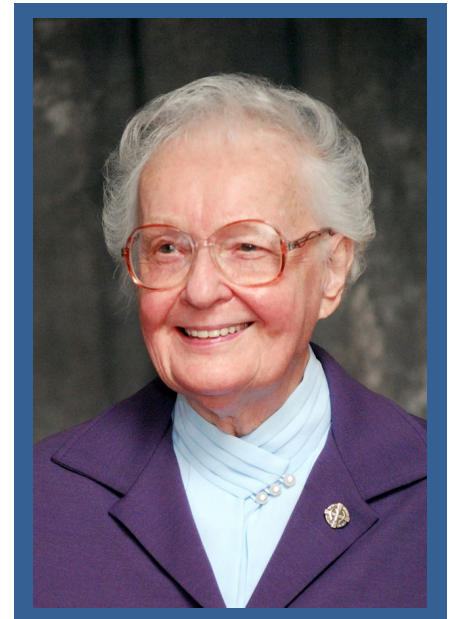

Sister Esther Smith, SSND

Sister Esther followed her 1942 profession with 45 years dedicated to teaching Catholic middle school students across the Midwest. Most of those schools were in the Milwaukee area, including Holy Angels in West Bend, one of her longest assignments, lasting from 1944 through 1954. She also taught 11 years at St. Casimir in Milwaukee during the 1970s and 1980s. She served on staff at S.E.T. in Milwaukee from 1987 through 1991, then moved to Waterloo, Illinois, for several years. From 1997 through 2007, she ministered full-time at the Sisters Interacting with Sisters apartment complex in Milwaukee. Currently, she resides at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, where she ministers in prayer and presence. She holds a bachelor's in English with a minor in history from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.
