Sister Caroline Markway, SSND

Sister Caroline began her full-time ministries in 1970. From 1970-1973, she taught at Sacred Heart School in DuQuoin, Illinois. She served elementary students at Catholic schools across St. Louis and Belleville, Illinois, and from 1974-1975, she taught at St. Joseph in Cairo, Illinois. Beginning in 1975, she devoted eight years at St. Bernadette in St. Louis, followed by 11 years at St. William School on the city's north side. In 1994, Sister Caroline answered a call to move to Montgomery City, Missouri, where she taught at Immaculate Conception School through the dawn of the new millennium. After a year-long sabbatical taking classes and workshops, she returned to St. Louis, continuing her teaching ministry at St. Timothy and St. Mark, and then accepting a position as Director of Notre Dame Preschool from 2006 through 2009. She has continued to serve the congregation through prayer and presence and currently ministers to fellow sisters at Veronica House in Bridgeton. Sister Caroline earned a bachelor's in American Studies from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis.
