## **Sister Janet Crane, SSND**

*Sister Janet was professed in 1968 as a School Sister of Notre Dame. She taught for three years in St Louis before entering the Redemptoristines in Liguori in the St. Louis Archdiocese. She returned to SSND as a business manager at Sancta Maria in Ripa in St. Louis, and professed again in 1995. Sister Janet then completed Clinical Pastoral Education at Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis and was a chaplain for people living with HIV/AIDS. In 2000, she was called to the District of Africa, working as a chaplain and training other chaplains and medical personnel in Kenya and the East African region. She received a bachelor's in American studies and art from the former Notre Dame College, and a master's in theological studies in 1998, and doctorate in ministry in 2012, from Eden Theological Seminary, St Louis. Since 2012, she has ministered as a chaplain for mothers and babies at Mercy Hospital in St Louis.*
