Sister Leslie Noonan, SSND

Sister Leslie taught both grade school and high school students in Texas, Mississippi, and in her home Diocese of New Orleans during her first decade of ministry. During the early 1980s, she continued her educational ministry in Texas. She gave a year of service at the Irving Motherhouse, and served the next year as a teacher in Fort Worth, then as coordinator of religious education at St. Gerard Majella in San Antonio. From 1987-1991, she continued in religious education at St. Joseph grade school in the Diocese of Lafayette, Louisiana. Following a year in congregational ministry in Chatawa, Mississippi, Sister Leslie served seven years as teacher at St. Mary grade school in Brownsville, Texas. Beginning in 2000, she devoted the next 16 years, to adult education at the Notre Dame Education Center in Canton, Mississippi. She has since returned to congregational service and music ministry at St. Mary of the Pines in Chatawa. Sister Leslie holds a bachelor's of music from the University of Dallas and a master's in religious education from Loyola University in New Orleans.
