## **Sister Lucy Nigh, SSND**

*Sister Lucy has devoted most of her 50-year ministry serving in her home state of Wisconsin. Her earliest years were spent in classrooms in Marshfield and Superior, St. John Baptist and St. Francis Xavier. From 1980-1984, she became a youth retreat director at Milwaukee's Tyme Out Center, after which she accepted a six-year, full-time post serving as director of vocations for the Milwaukee province. Sister Lucy devoted much of the next decade to hospital chaplaincy, serving at both Children's and St. Michael's in Milwaukee. From 1997-2005, she ministered in Elm Grove, Wisconsin, serving as a provincial councilor for the SSND congregation, followed by a three-year post as the congregation's director of an international renewal program in Rome. She returned to the U.S., where she turned her attention to border ministry, living and working in Douglas, Arizona, in the Diocese of Tucson. She continues this work full-time. Sister Lucy earned a bachelor's in education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee in 1971. She also holds a master's in religious studies from Chicago's Mundelein College.*
