Sister Mary Theresa began her ministry in Houston, Texas, teaching elementary students at Our Lady of Mount Carmel from 1970-1977. Following short teaching stints around New Orleans and Dallas, Sister Theresa turned to pastoral ministry. She served in a dual ministry from 1980-1992, for St. Michael parish in Bedford, Texas, and as vicar for religious with the Diocese of Fort Worth. She continued in parish administration at Good Shepherd in Colleyville, serving full-time through 2007. Since 2008, Sister Theresa has worked for the Diocese of Dallas as a ministries director. She earned a bachelor's in theology and English from the University of Dallas. In 1981, she completed a master's in theology degree, awarded by St. Louis University.
