After her studies at St. Mary's hospital in St. Louis, she received her license as a practical nurse. She tended the retired and sick at Villa Gesu and a few years at Sancta Maria in Ripa. In 1983, Sister Richarda cared for the retired and sick sisters at Nazareth Living Center for three years. Following this, Sister Richarda accepted a staff position at Notre Dame Hall in St. Louis. From 1990-1995, she was a teacher's aide at St. Mary's Special School. She worked several years in food service for Immaculate Conception School, in Montgomery City, Missouri. In 2000, she experienced time with the Whole Health Outreach program in Ellington, Missouri. From 2003-2011, Sister Richarda was the evening supervisor in food service at Nazareth Living Center in St. Louis. Currently, she serves full-time as a Community Coordinator at Veronica House in St. Louis.
