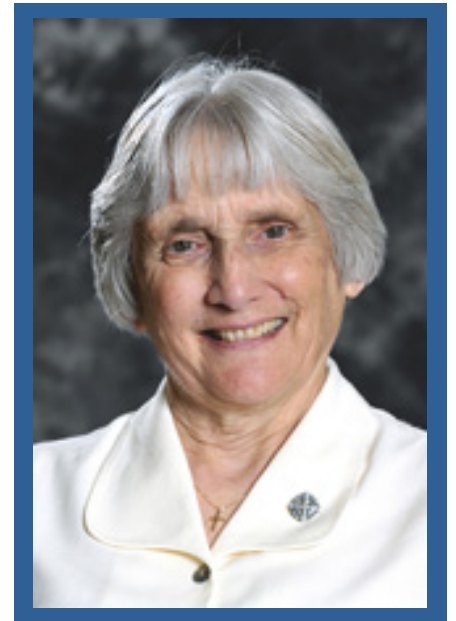

Sister Sharon Stecker, SSND

Sister Sharon has devoted the majority of her ministry in her home state of Wisconsin. Following her studies in the late 1960's, she served as an elementary teacher at three Catholic grade schools: St. Peter in Port Washington, St. Joseph in Black River Falls, and Holy Angels in West Bend. In 1981, she accepted a role in pastoral ministry and coordinator of religious education at Sacred Heart, Calumet, in the Marquette diocese. Moving to the Green Bay diocese in 1984, she served six years as director of religious education at St. Frances Assisi, Coleman, followed by eight years at St. Willebrord in Green Bay. After receiving a certificate in English as Second Language from University of Wisconsin – Green Bay, Sister Sharon turned to adult education for the Milwaukee Achiever Literacy Program in Milwaukee, serving in various coordinator roles for a decade. In 2009, she became part-time instructor in alternative GED education. Since 2014, she has served as director of the Rising Stars Volunteer Program at the SSND offices in Elm Grove. She holds a bachelor's in elementary education from Mount College in Milwaukee, and a master's in religious studies from Aquinas College in Grand Rapids.
