## **Sister Susan Clark, SSND**

*Sister Susan has devoted her entire ministry serving in her home state of Wisconsin. From 1969 through 1979, she held teaching positions in the dioceses of Milwaukee and LaCrosse, serving at Christ the King in Milwaukee, St. Charles Borromeo in Chippewa Falls, and St. John Nepomucene, Prairie du Chien. She served the next four years at Pacelli High School in Stevens Point, serving in campus ministry and teaching. Beginning in 1986, Sister Susan engaged in campus ministry and teaching at St. Joseph Academy in Green Bay, followed by two years in pastoral work on the Menominee Reservation in Keshena. She was called to serve as a Provincial Councilor from 1991-1997. By the dawn of the new millennium, Sister Susan had turned to a new ministry in chaplaincy at the Oshkosh Correctional Institution. In 2010, she relocated to Lakewood, Wisconsin, to care for an aging family member. Since 2016, she has served full-time at Our Lady of the Angels as a community leader for the Greenfield community. Sister Susan earned a bachelor's degree in education at Mount Mary College in Milwaukee, and holds a master's in Christian Spirituality from Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska.*
