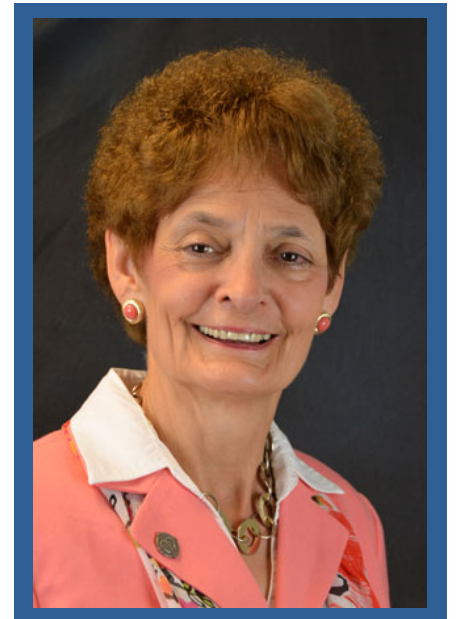

Sister Theresa began her ministry teaching primary, middle and upper grade school students at Catholic schools across St. Louis, Cape Girardeau, Missouri, and Belleville, Illinois. In 1976, she began a decade-long stint at St. Francis Borgia Grade School in Washington, Missouri, where she taught Religion and worked as a Director of Religious Education. Sister Theresa turned her attention to Director of Religious Education, as well as Pastoral Ministry serving at St. Matthias parish in St. Louis from 1986-1990. She then followed a calling to accept a similar role at the Cathedral of St. Peter in Belleville, Illinois, in the Diocese of her hometown of Aviston, where she ministers full-time. She serves as Director of Religious Education/ Pastoral Associate for the parish. Sister Theresa earned a bachelor's in American Studies from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. She holds a master's in Religious Studies from Mundelein College in Chicago.
