Sister Ann taught at numerous Catholic Grade Schools throughout the 1960s and early 1970s in the upper Midwest including Iowa, Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota. She accepted roles in administration at Sacred Heart, Eden, South Dakota; Sts. Peter and Paul, New Hradec, North Dakota; and Sts. Peter and Paul, Blue Earth, Minnesota. From 1973-1976, she served in pastoral ministry in the Archdiocese of Dubuque, Iowa. She taught one year at St. Anthony School, Lismore, Minnesota, before ministering to the Sisters in Marian Hall at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato. Following that position, she again taught primary grades at IC-St. Joseph's, Gilbertville-Raymond, Iowa. From 1986-2012, she taught primary grades at St. Pius X School, Rochester, Minnesota; and St. Matthew's School, St. Thomas the Apostle School and St. Theresa School, Phoenix, Arizona. Upon retiring from full-time teaching in 2012, she was hired by the Diocese of Phoenix to instruct foreign-born priests in accent reduction. She has continued that ministry while additionally offering that same guidance in speaking and understanding American English to sisters from Korea.
