## **Sister Carol Ann Gosse, SSND**

*Sister Carol Ann served her earliest ministry years teaching middle school students around the Minnesota Diocese of Winona, St. Paul, and New Ulm. From 1959-1973, she devoted herself to the children at: St. Peter and Paul in Blue Earth, St. Matthew in St. Paul, John Ireland in St. Peter, St. Mary in Shakopee, and St. Stanislaus in Winona. Following interim years of congregational services between 1972-1975, Sister Carol Ann returned to teaching by serving at Trinity High School in Dickinson, North Dakota from 1975-1979. Returning to Minnesota, she turned to a new role as director of religious education, serving three schools between 1979 and 2000: St. Gabriel in Fulda, St. Phillip in Litchfield, and St. Michael in St. Cloud. The remainder of Sister Carol Ann's full-time ministry has been spent in pastoral care at the parishes of Immaculate Conception in Rice, St. Anthony in St. Cloud, and — since 2006 — St. Odilia in Shoreview. She earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and a master's degree in religious studies from St. Mary's College in Winona.*
