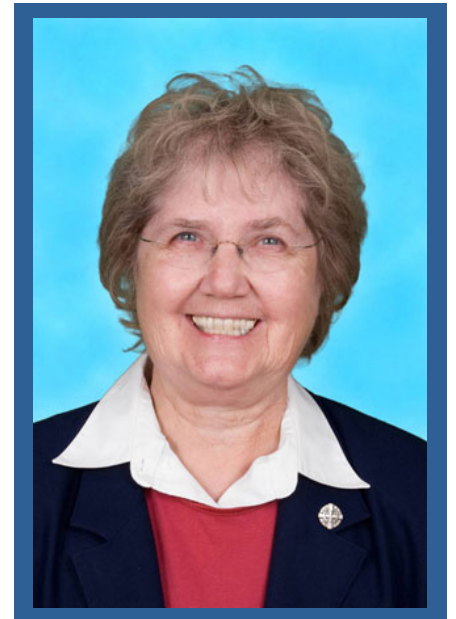

Sister Corrine Dahlheimer, SSND

Sister Corrine devoted the earliest decades of ministry to teaching primary grades across Minnesota. Her assignments took her to St. Stanislaus in Winona, St. Francis de Sales, Corpus Christi, St. Mathew, St. Paul, St. Dominic's in Northfield and Epiphany in Coon Rapids. Sister Corrine turned to pastoral ministries working as Director of Volunteers for Epiphany Parish in Coon Rapids from 1985-2003. Part-time jobs consisted of the following: receptionist for a local podiatrist, activities for residents in the assisted living memory care unit, sacramental coordinator of First Sacraments and spiritual counselor for Mary T. Inc. (hospice). Care-giving to friends and family members was also a vital part of her ministry in retirement. Her bachelor's degree in elementary education turned out to be education "in the broadest sense."
