## **Sister Gloria T. List, SSND**

*Sister Gloria T. has devoted herself to the ministry of dentistry since completing her doctor of dental surgery degree from Marquette University in Milwaukee, in 1964. For most of the years between 1964-1981, she served as a dentist at Notre Dame of the Lake motherhouse in Mequon, Wisconsin. Between 1967-1970, she also worked part-time as a high school teacher at Caroline Academy in Mequon. During the summer of 1969, Sister Gloria was in Paraguay with the SSND sister missionaries and priests from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee doing dentistry work. Beginning in 1970 and continuing through 2005, Sister Gloria served as a professor at Marquette University in Milwaukee. During the years 1981-1989, she was also active in dentistry in a private practice. In 2006, she reduced her full-time work at Marquette to part-time, remaining an adjunct professor since 2013. Prior to obtaining her DDS degree, Sister Gloria earned a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In 1981, she graduated with a master's degree in theology from Marquette University.*
