Sister Jacqueline began her ministry teaching middle school students at Sacred Heart of Jesus in New Orleans. After two years, she moved to California, teaching in several dioceses there through 1981. Those assignments included seven years at St. Marianne de Paredes in Pico Rivera; one year at Holy Family in San Diego; and 11 years at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Indio, where she served a dual role as teacher and administrator. Sister Jacqueline returned to the Midwest, accepting an assignment at St. Anthony Grade School in Quincy, Illinois, a post she held through 1995. Continuing in full-time education, she relocated to Dardenne, Missouri, teaching middle school students at Immaculate Conception through 2007. She has since moved back to Quincy, where she serves as a part-time chaplain at St. Vincent Nursing Home. Sister Jacqueline earned a bachelor's degree in English from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. She earned a master's degree in education/English from Loyola Marymount in Los Angeles.
