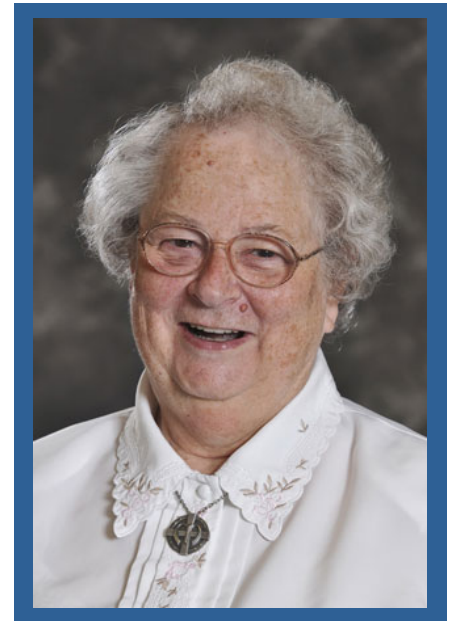

Sister Jeanette Marie Wieland, SSND

Sister Jeanette Marie has devoted her decades of ministry to teaching and congregational service across the Midwest. Her first teaching assignment took her to Chicago, where she taught primary grades at St. Anthony from 1960-1965. Returning to her hometown of Milwaukee, she taught middle school students through 1984, at St. Cyril and Methodius, St. Mary Czestochowa, and St. John de Nepomuc. That year, she moved to Indiana, where she served through 1990, at St. Peter and Paul near Gary, followed by four years at Sacred Heart in the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend. Returning to Milwaukee, Sister Jeanette Marie devoted the next four years to congregational leadership, serving as a local leader assistant at Notre Dame of Elm Grove through 2001, followed by four years as a community leader at Havenwood Nursing & Rehabilitation. Sister Jeanette turned her attention to literacy education, serving four years at Milwaukee Achiever Literacy, followed by two years of volunteer tutoring with Rising Stars. She currently resides in prayer and presence at Our Lady of the Angels residence in Greenfield, near Milwaukee. Sister Jeanette Marie holds a bachelor's degree in mathematics/physics from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In 1976, she earned a master's degree in math education from Clarke College in Dubuque.
