Sister Joel Marie has spent the majority of her ministry years in and around St. Louis. Her first teaching assignments throughout the 1960s and early 1970s included serving at the Catholic schools of: Immaculate Heart of Mary, St. William, All Souls, Sacred Heart (Eureka), and Notre Dame Elementary. From 1973-1987, she devoted her time to students in the Diocese of Belleville, Illinois, at St. Dominic in Breese; St. Philip in East St. Louis; and St. Peter in Belleville. During the early 1990s, she served once again at Sacred Heart, as well as at St. Stephen in Caseyville. Sister Joel Marie followed her call to Notre Dame High School in St. Louis, where she served as supervisor of the testing center from 1995-2011. She continues today in volunteer services at the high school and at Theresa Center. Sister Joel Marie holds a bachelor's degree in elementary education from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. In 1969, she earned a master's degree in elementary education from St. Louis University.
