Sister Margaret Ann devoted her entire active ministry to teaching in Catholic grade schools and high schools in Wisconsin and Michigan. Her first assignment took her to St. Cyril and Methodius in Milwaukee, where she taught primary grades from 1960-1963. Following a two-year assignment at St. Adalbert in Grand Rapids, Michigan, Sister Margaret Ann relocated to Huntington, Indiana, where she taught at Huntington Catholic High School from 1965-1972. She returned to Grand Rapids, accepting a teaching assignment at West Catholic High School, where she served through 1983. She concluded her teaching ministry at Pacelli High School in Stevens Point, Wisconsin, where she served 26 years full-time, followed by two years part time. Sister Margaret Ann continues in volunteer ministry and serves in prayer and presence at the SSND residence in Stevens Point. She holds both a bachelor's and master's degree in Spanish. She earned her undergraduate degree from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and the graduate degree from the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana.
