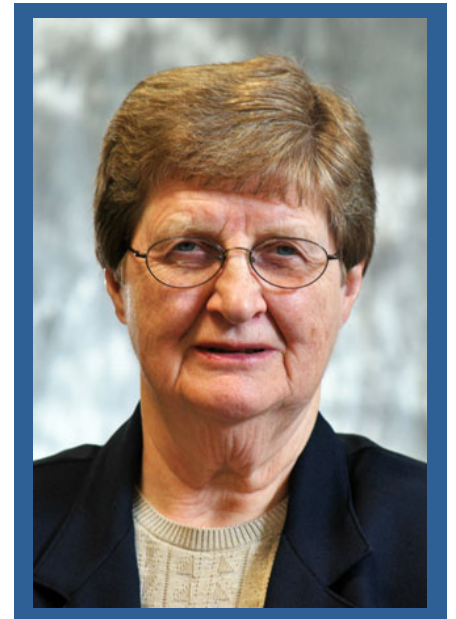

Sister Margaret Gaier, SSND

Sister Margaret devoted the early years of her ministry in various roles around the Milwaukee diocese. She taught from 1960-1964 at St. Hyacinth and St. Bruno Schools, followed by two years in congregational service at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Mount Calvary. Completing her bachelor's degree in occupational therapy at Mount Mary College in Milwaukee in 1968, Sister Margaret returned to Our Lady of Mount Carmel as an occupational therapist until 1974. She served in similar roles through 1981 at Elm Grove's Notre Dame Health Care Center and the Sisters of St. Francis Motherhouse in Milwaukee. Following several interim assignments, she moved to the Diocese of St. Cloud, serving on staff at the Wholistic Growth Resource Center from 1986-1989, followed by several years' service on staff at the Diocese of St. Cloud. Returning to Milwaukee in the mid 1990s, Sister Margaret returned to the Sisters of St. Francis Motherhouse as a bookkeeper and office assistant, a 14-year post that concluded in 2008. She extended her ministry in finance assistance at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, serving there through 2012. In the years since, she has resided at the SSND residence in Milwaukee working as a finance assistant at Notre Dame of Elm Grove.
