## **Sister Maria Regina Paulino, SSND**

*Sister Maria Regina has ministered in her home country of Guam since her first profession of vows. From 1959-1969, she taught Catholic middle school students at San Vicente in Barrigada and Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Agat. She moved into secondary education, serving students at Notre Dame High School in Talofofo through 1974, when she accepted a four-year post as a grade school principal at St. Francis in Yona. Sister Maria Regina continued in high school teaching and administration through 1986, when she returned to the U.S. to complete her doctorate in private school administration. She returned to Guam in 1990, serving as principal at Our Lady of Mount Carmel through 1993, when she accepted a three-year post as superintendent of Catholic schools for the Diocese of Agana. Sister Maria Regina served as a regional councilor in Guam during two different periods: from 1995-1997, and again from 2005-2008. Between these posts, she returned to Notre Dame High School in Talofofo as principal, then as president and mission advancement director of the school. She returned to the U.S. in 2009, and resides in prayer and presence at Our Lady of the Angels in Greenfield, Wisconsin. Prior to receiving her Ph.D., Sister Maria Regina earned both undergraduate and master's degrees at the University of Guam.*
