Sister Marie has devoted the whole of her ministry in her home Diocese of Winona, Minnesota. She began teaching Catholic grade school students in 1959, her first assignment at St. Isidore in Litomysl lasting through 1966. Over the next decade, she taught at St. John the Baptist in Savage, St. Peter and Paul in Mankato, St. Casimir in Wells, and St. John the Baptist in Searles. Beginning in 1976, she returned to St. Casimir, both teaching and serving in administration through 1986. Continuing on in the classroom, Sister Marie devoted her time to students at St. Mary in Madelia through 1990, followed by a one-year assignment at St. Felix in Wabasha. She turned then to serving the congregation at Our Lady of Good Counsel, as transportation director from 1991-2006, continuing full-time in a similar role at the provincial level in Mankato through 2010. She has continued to serve the community at Our Lady of Good Counsel in the years since. Sister Marie earned a bachelor's degree in education in 1967 from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.
