Sister Mary Lynn Heiser, SSND

Sister Mary Lynn devoted her earliest ministry years as a teacher and musician at Catholic schools across several Wisconsin dioceses. From 1960-1962 she taught elementary students at St. Agnes in Butler. She served three years as parish organist and teacher at St. Francis Xavier in De Pere, followed by four years in similar ministry at St. Henry in Watertown, and five years at St. Mary in West Bend. Sister Mary Lynn returned to classroom teaching and elementary administration in 1975, serving at St. Peter in Port Washington through 1986. She continued in teaching and administration at the high school level for another two decades, serving at Notre Dame High School in Milwaukee, St. Louis in Caledonia, and St. Catherine's High School in Racine, where she was stationed for 13 years. Sister Mary Lynn moved to Phoenix, where she has since served part-time in congregational ministries coordinating the SSND housing/condo complex in Sun City. She has also undertaken volunteer roles at St. Clement parish and at the Sun City Posse as chaplain and in patrolling. She holds a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In 1990, she earned a master's degree in education from Marian College in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin.
