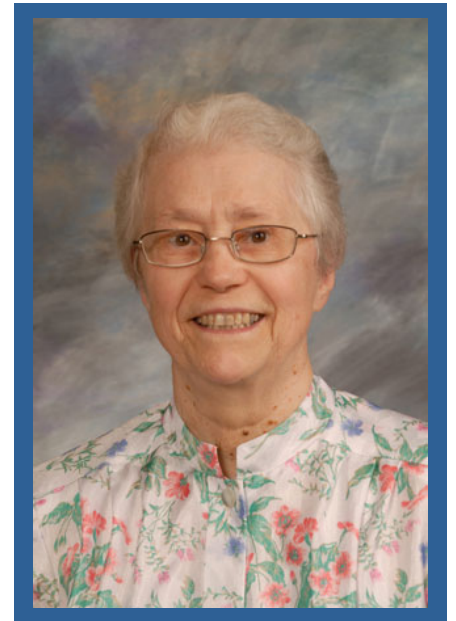

Sister Marylyn has served as an educator and nurse throughout numerous dioceses across Minnesota. She began as an elementary teacher in Catholic grade schools, her first post at St. Matthew in St. Paul, from 1959-1963. Other early assignments include St. Joseph in Silver Lake, St. Agnes in St. Paul, St. Stanislaus in Winona, Holy Rosary in North Mankato, and St. Peter in Canby. From 1974-1978, she held teaching roles at St. Martin in Rogers and Crucifixion in LaCrescent. During the early 1980s, Sister Marylyn served in pastoral work as a receptionist for Holy Spirit parish in St. Cloud, followed by several years of congregational service at Good Counsel Education Center in Mankato. Beginning in 1988, she followed a new call into healthcare, working at Our Lady of Good Counsel as a nurse's aide through 1992, when she attended St. Mary's School of Nursing to obtain her licensed practical nursing certification. Relocating to New Prague, she began a three-year post at Mala Strana Health Care Center, followed by four years at Lourdes Health Care Center in Wilton, Connecticut. Since returning to Mankato in late 2002, Sister Marylyn has served as an LPN at Our Lady of Good Counsel. Prior to her LPN licensure, she earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education at Mount Mary College in Milwaukee.
