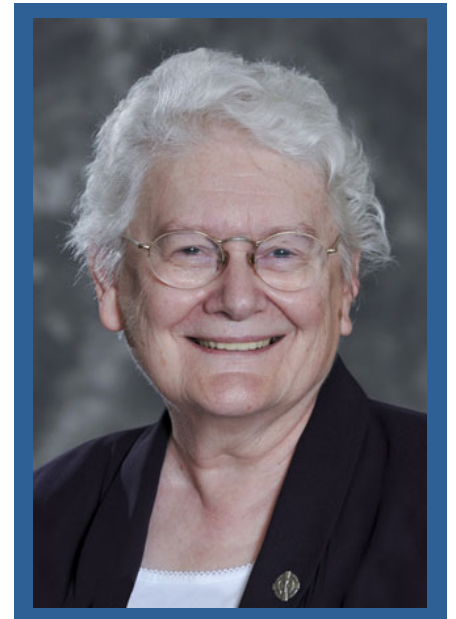

## **Sister Patricia Ann Obremski, SSND**

*Sister Patricia Ann taught middle school and high school students early in her ministry years. The longest of these posts took her to Academy of Our Lady in Chicago for four years, followed by a decade of service at Notre Dame High School in Milwaukee. In 1976, Sister Patricia Ann accepted a professorship at Mount Mary University in Milwaukee, teaching at various levels over the years. Her most recent post as associate professor of chemistry and physics commenced in 2013. Sister Patricia Ann earned her undergraduate degree in chemistry and physics from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. In 1975, she earned a master's degree in chemistry from Marquette University in Milwaukee. In 1988, she completed her doctorate in education (philosophy of education foundations), also at Marquette. Sister Patricia Ann also did post graduate research in surface science at the University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee.*
