Sister Rosalind Santos, SSND

Sister Rosalind has devoted the great majority of her active ministry teaching on the island of Guam. During the 1960s, she served at the Catholic schools of San Vicente in Barrigada and Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Agat. She taught at St. Francis in Yona from 1971-1973, when she moved to the Caroline Islands for a three-year post serving middle school students at St. Mary. She returned to St. Francis, teaching there through 1982, followed by brief assignments back in the Caroline Islands and again at San Vicente. Over the next decade, Sister Mary Rosalind ministered as an AHRD employment development worker. From 1995-1997, she served the congregation at the Talofofo Notre Dame Regional House, leaving there to care for family members in Yona through the early 2000s. She undertook several ministries while residing in prayerful presence in Talofofo throughout the period of 2005-2011. Returning to the U.S., Sister Mary Rosalind has continued in prayerful witness at Notre Dame of Elm Grove. She graduated in 1971 from the University of Guam with a bachelor of arts degree in education.
