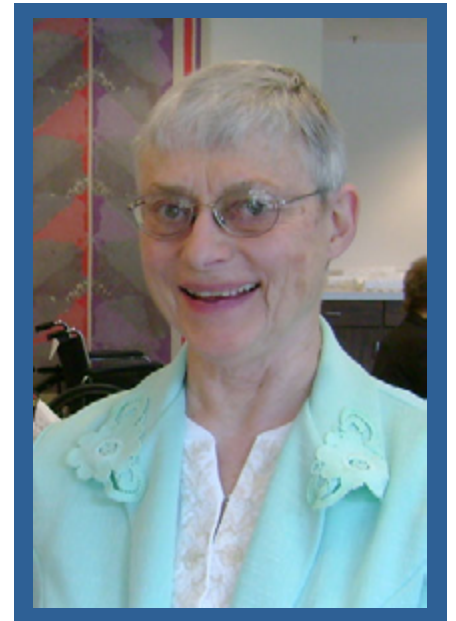

## **Sister Rose Andre Beck, SSND**

*Sister Rose Andre devoted her earliest ministry decades to teaching primary grades in Catholic schools across the Green Bay and Milwaukee dioceses. The longest of these assignments was at Holy Trinity School, from 1965-1969. She also served as administrator of St. Mary's in Burlington, from 1974-1977. Sister Mary then turned to adult religious education and pastoral ministry, devoting herself to the parishioners at Sacred Heart in Emmonak, Alaska, from 1977 through 1991. Following several short non-teaching assignments around Wisconsin, she returned to the classroom from 1996-2002, teaching middle school at Notre Dame School of Milwaukee. After the dawn of the new millennium, Sister Mary turned her focus to earth spirituality, promoting organic gardening and coordinating husbandry for both the SUNSEED Eco-Education Center and the Our Lady of Mount Carmel Home in Mount Calvary, Wisconsin. Since 2012, she has ministered as a volunteer and through prayer and presence across Green Bay and Elm Grove. She holds a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and earned a master's degree in education from the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana.*
