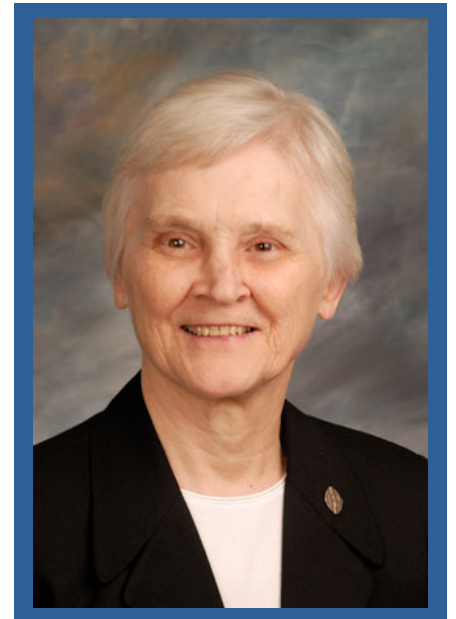

Sister Rose Anthony Krebs, SSND

Sister Rose Anthony has devoted the majority of her ministry years to teaching. From 1959-1975, she served in three Minnesota Catholic grade schools: St. Agnes in St. Paul, St. John in Mankato, and St. Michael in Madison. In 1975, she followed her call to Spokane, Washington, serving again as an elementary grade teacher at Trinity School through 1981. The next nine years were spent in the classroom at St. Francis Xavier in Sartell, Minnesota. Sister Rose Anthony then answered the call to missionary teaching. She traveled to Kenya in August 1990, spending nearly a decade at three elementary schools in Kisumu and Kisii. Returning to the U.S. in 1999, she continued classroom teaching until 2005, serving at St. Raphael in Springfield, Minnesota. Sister Rose Anthony turned to congregational ministry, serving at Our Lady of Good Counsel in Mankato, as sacristan and director of craft activities, through 2010. She continues to minister full-time through sharing her artistic talents. She holds a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee. She later earned a master's degree in reading education from Cardinal Stritch University, also in Milwaukee.
