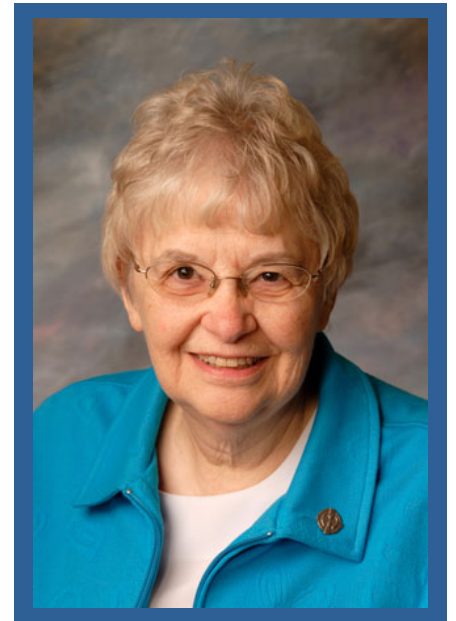

## **Sister Suzanne Eichler, SSND**

*Sister Suzanne devoted her earliest ministry years to teaching in her home state of Minnesota. Her initial assignment took her to St. Stanislaus in St. Paul from 1959-1963. She spent three years at St. Joseph the Worker in Mankato, then moved to Gilbertville, Iowa, teaching at Immaculate Conception until 1970. She returned to Mankato, where she ministered in elementary school administration at St. Joseph-St. John through 1979, followed by six years in a similar role at St. Dominic in Northfield. Following pastoral ministry studies, she devoted herself full-time time in ministering to homeless women at Incarnation House in Minneapolis — a post she held for seven years. From 1996-2013, Sister Suzanne served in the Archdiocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis Catholic Schools Office as coordinator of re-licensure and personnel placement. Since 2013, she has volunteered part-time at three different offices in St. Paul: Archdiocesan Stewardship/Development, Catholic Cemeteries, and MORE (an SSND supported ministry). She holds a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College in Milwaukee and a master's degree in education-counseling/guidance from Loras College in Dubuque. In 1987, she earned a Pastoral Ministry Certificate at the College of St. Catherine in St. Paul, Minnesota.*
